Registration for all tests, except the American Sign Language Proficiency Interview (ASLPI), must be completed **at least two full days before the test date** (not including the day of registration and the day of the test). Registration for the ASLPI should be completed at least **4 weeks prior to the date you would like to test**. Registration for the Teacher Leadership assessment must be completed by **October 19, 2020**, for the October 27, 2020, submission deadline, and by **March 11, 2021**, for the March 18, 2021, submission deadline. There is no set registration period for the Georgia Ethics and Paraprofessional assessments; they can be taken at any time.

About the Assessments

The GACE Website

Interactive Practice Tests

After completing the practice test, the user can see if the selected-response questions were answered correctly or incorrectly and get explanations for the correct answers. Some IPTs also include practice constructed-response questions. Feedback is not provided for constructed-response questions.
